Loudoun County, Virginia Launches New Enterprise Resource Planning System

Naperville, IL January 17, 2014: On July 1, 2013 Loudoun County, Virginia successfully launched their new Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) software system, marking the end of the first of three phases in a 36-month project. This system uses Oracle E-Business Suite software and replaces financial and procurement systems that have been in place for more than 30 years.

This first phase launch of the ERP project is a significant milestone in Loudoun County's efforts to continuously improve services for its residents, students and businesses. The County government and Loudoun County Public Schools went live simultaneously.

"This is a major accomplishment for Loudoun County Government and schools," noted County Administrator Tim Hemstreet. "The project team deserves congratulations for a job well done—this phase of the project came in on-schedule and on-budget."
